ABSENTEE VOTING BY MAIL

SATURDAY, SEPT 21 – TUESDAY, OCT 22, 2024

In order to vote by mail you must have a qualifying reason per KRS 117.085.

Make your request at www.govote.ky.gov or by phone at 270-444-4702 by OCTOBER 22, 2024.

You may return your ballot through the mail or place it in the drop box outside the McCracken County Courthouse during business hours.

Your ballot must be in our drop box or received by mail by 6 p.m. on November 5, 2024 (Election Day).

IN-PERSON ABSENTEE VOTING

8:30 A.M. – 4:30 P.M.

In order to vote during In-Person Absentee Voting, you must have a qualifying reason per KRS 117.085.
