V. TABLED FROM PREVIOUS MEETINGS

A. It is ordered to pay the invoices listed below to Barkley Regional Airport Authority for new terminal expenses, in the amount of \$33,391.42. This amount is one-half of the total invoices of \$66,782.84 and is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated August 28, 2021, between City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Barkley Regional Airport Authority.

B. It is ordered to pay the invoices listed below to Barkley Regional Airport Authority for new terminal expenses, in the amount of \$342,511.05. VI. COURT ORDERS

- A. It is hereby ordered that pursuant to KRS Chapter 68.005, the McCracken County Administrative Code has been reviewed and is hereby adopted by the majority of the McCracken County Fiscal Court, at this meeting held on June 12, 2023.
- B. It is ordered that Roy Roberts be hired as a part-time Certified Court Security Officer at a rate of \$12.35 per hour effective June 13, 2023.

- C. It is ordered that bid openings were held at 10:00 am on May 24, 2023 at the McCracken County Courthouse for Bituminous Asphalt Paving for the period of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024. One bid was received, that being from Jim Smith Contracting and was taken under advisement.
- D. It is ordered that the bid for Bituminous Asphalt Paving for the period of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 be awarded to Jim Smith Contracting.
- E. It is ordered that bid openings were held at 10:00 am on May 24, 2023 at the McCracken County Courthouse for stone for the period of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024. One bid was received, that being Vulcan Materials and was taken under advisement.
- F. It is ordered that the bid for stone for the period of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 be awarded to Vulcan Materials.
- G. It is ordered bid openings were held at 10:00 am on May 24, 2023 at the McCracken County Courthouse for delivered fuel for the period of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024. One bid was received, that being from JSC Terminal LLC d/b/a Midwest Terminal and was taken under advisement.
- H. It is ordered that the bid for delivered fuel for the period of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 be awarded to JSC Terminal LLC d/b/a Midwest Terminal.
- It is hereby ordered that the attached plan, including both the scope of work and project estimates, for the Stuart Nelson Dog Park relocation be approved as part of the athletic complex. The Fiscal Court's consent is required by Section 1.5 (a) of the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for the Development of the Paducah-McCracken County Athletic Complex.
- J. It is hereby ordered that the attached plan, including both the scope of work for the Selective Interior Demolition project of the grandstand structure and adjacent building, be approved as part of the scope of work for the athletic complex. The Fiscal Court's consent is required by Section 1.5 (a) and (b) of the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for the Development of the Paducah-McCracken County Athletic Complex.
- K. It is hereby ordered that the Judge Executive is authorized to enter a contract with Bacon, Farmer and Workmen Engineering and Testing Inc., in the amount of \$72,600 for master planning services at Carson Park.
- L. It is ordered that the Judge Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Construction Safety Consultants, Inc. for safety services and drug screening for the McCracken County Road Department at unit

- prices and hourly rates in accordance with the agreement for the fiscal year 2023-2024. Further, the Judge Executive is authorized to execute any documents necessary to enter into said agreement with CSC.
- M. It is ordered that the Treasurer is authorized to pay to the McCracken County NAACP the amount of \$2,000.00 for sponsorship of the 2023 Juneteenth celebration.

This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County. Further, the Treasurer is authorized to transfer \$23,386.85 from the General Fund to the Sports Complex Project Fund.
- P. It is ordered that an Annual Standing Order be approved for the Pre-Approval of recurring expenses for utilities, telephone, payroll, debt service, and employee health benefits bills for Fiscal Year 2023-2024.
- Q. It is ordered to pay the invoices listed below to Barkley Regional Airport Authority for new terminal expenses, in the amount of \$348,012.66. This amount is one-half of the total invoices of \$696,025.32 and is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated August 28, 2021, between City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Barkley Regional Airport Authority.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2018-004 BY AMENDING THE DEFINITIONS OF "NET INCOME" AND "NET FEES" AND EXPANDING THE SCOPE OF PERMISSIBLE CHECKS DRAWN FROM THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE FEE ACCOUNT

Summary: The action effectuated in the present Ordinance is authorized by Kentucky Attorney General Opinions 74-01 and 81-303 and Kentucky Revised Statutes Sections 67.080 and 67.083. This Ordinance amends Ordinance No. 2018-004 by changing the definitions of "net income" and "net fees" by excepting certain transmittals from their meaning and by expanding the scope of permissible checks that may be drawn by the Sheriff's Office out of their fee account.

Summary: The action taken by the present Ordinance is required by Kentucky revised statutes Chapter 68 and is carried out in strict compliance with the same. After detailed investigation by the McCracken

County Fiscal Court into each separate activity of the county and necessary funding requirements for the provision of the same, a proposed county budget is now prepared and submitted for approval of the Fiscal Court with expenditure allocated to budget units as classified below:
