### **I. CONSENT AGENDA**

It is ordered to approve the Consent Agenda for April 13, 2026, McCracken County Fiscal Court.

### **II. BUDGET TRANSFERS**

It is ordered that the necessary cash transfers, in the amount of \_\_\_\_\_ be made in order to pay County bills and payroll approved April 13, 2026.

### **III. ACCOUNTS PAYABLE**

It is ordered to approve the Voucher Claims Register from March 23, 2026, to April 13, 2026, to show County bills in the amount of \_\_\_\_\_ were paid.

### **IV. BOARD APPOINTMENT**

A. It is ordered that Conner Murt is appointed to the Zoning Board of Adjustment to complete the term of Alan Robinson ending June 30, 2028.

- B. It is ordered that Valerie Coffelt is appointed to the Zoning Board of Adjustment to complete the term of Ted Smith ending June 30, 2029.
- C. It is ordered that Jeremy Goodman is appointed to the Melber-New Hope Fire Board to complete the term of Donald Powers ending October 31, 2027.

**V. COURT ORDERS**

- A. It is ordered that the Treasurer is authorized to prepare the budget to include a wage increase of 8% Market Correction plus 2.7% COLA for all non-bargaining employees of McCracken County not included in the orders of March 26, 2026. The Treasurer is further authorized to update pay grid ordinances reflecting the same. No position shall exceed the salary of the highest elected official.
- B. It is ordered that the Judge Executive is authorized to sign the 2026 SAR Affiliation Agreement.
- C. It is ordered to pay the City of Paducah \$637.50 this being ¼ the amount of the catering invoice for the Warrior Wednesday lunch held in Ft. Campbell as part of the veteran's recruitment effort. Other contributors are the City of Paducah, GPED and the Chamber of Commerce.
- D. It is hereby ordered to approve Change Order No. 1 with Murtco, Inc., reducing the bid amount by \$34,845.00 from \$119,845.00 to \$85,000.00 for the walk-in cooler/freezer at the Paducah Sports Park.
- E. It is hereby ordered that A&K Construction Change Order Number 006C, as shown on the attached documents and dated 4-15-2026, be approved. In summary, the change order agrees to decrease the contract by \$119,800.00. The new A&K Construction contract amount will be \$50,936,790.92. Contract changes include a \$19,800.00 credit for the direct purchase of Wi-Fi/Fiber & access control installation from R Carr & Associates and KeeFORCE, and the removal of \$100,000.00 for the Stuart Nelson Memorial Plaza. It is further ordered that Judge Executive is authorized to sign all documents necessary to effectuate the amended contract. It is further ordered that the Treasurer is authorized to pay invoices related to the same.
- F. It is ordered that the McCracken County Fiscal Court will direct owner purchase wifi/fiber & access control from KeeFORCE in the amount of \$82,265.85 to be funded by the FF&E Budget approved by the McCracken County Fiscal Court on June 24, 2024.
- G. It is ordered that the McCracken County Fiscal Court will direct owner purchase wifi/fiber & access control from R Carr & Associates in the amount of

\$115,274.85 to be funded by the FF&E Budget approved by the McCracken County Fiscal Court on June 24, 2024.

- H. It is ordered to pay the invoice dated March 11, 2026, to BFW for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$13,660.89. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.
- I. It is ordered to pay the invoice dated March 20, 2026, to Uline for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$19,626.90. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.
- J. It is ordered to pay the invoice dated March 25, 2026, to World Class Athletic Surfaces for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$3,867.00. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.
- K. It is ordered to pay the invoice dated March 4, 2026, to Pet Waste Eliminator for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$2,166.99. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.
- L. It is ordered to pay the invoice dated April 2, 2026, to United Electrical for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$4,907.00. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.
- M. It is ordered to pay the invoices dated March 25, 2026, to Trailer Country, Inc. for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$5,190.00. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.

- N. It is ordered to pay the Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$218,000.00. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.
  
- O. It is ordered to pay the Kentucky Natural Lands Trust for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$49,977.60. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.
  
- P. It is ordered to engage Patrick and Associates, LLC, to perform audit services for McCracken County Fiscal Court for a period beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026.
  
- Q. It is hereby ordered to amend an order approved by the Fiscal Court on March 23, 2026. The local match for the Metropolitan Transportation Planning (MPO) for FY26 is \$6,174.00 not \$4,126.50.
  
- R. It is ordered to approve the March 2026 Transient Room Tax in the amount of \$315,884.11 be disbursed as follows:
