I. CONSENT AGENDA

It is ordered to approve the Consent Agenda for April 28, 2026, McCracken County Fiscal Court.

II. BUDGET TRANSFERS

It is ordered that the necessary cash transfers, in the amount of \$50,000.00 be made in order to pay County bills and payroll approved April 28, 2026.

III. ACCOUNTS PAYABLE

It is ordered to approve the Voucher Claims Register from April 13, 2026, to April 28, 2026, to show County bills in the amount of \$248,128.61 were paid.

V. BOARD APPOINTMENT

- A. It is ordered that Kevin Whittler is appointed to the Concord Fire Board to complete the term of Levi Hensley that expires June 30, 2027.

VI. COURT ORDERS

- A. It is ordered that the Treasurer is authorized to prepare the budget to include a wage increase of 6.5% Market Correction plus 2.7% COLA for all non-bargaining employees of McCracken County not included in the orders of March 26, 2026. The Treasurer is further authorized to update pay grid ordinances reflecting the same. No position shall exceed the salary of the highest elected official.
- B. It is ordered that the salary of the McCracken County Commissioners is increased to the sum of \$2,901.49 per month (\$34,817.90 annually), less statutory deductions. This is pursuant to KRS 64.530 (3) which requires that the monthly compensation of county officers (except the Judge Executive, the County Clerk, the Jailer, and the Sheriff as set out in KRS 64.535) elected by popular vote and including the County Attorney, the salary of the “officer and of his deputies and assistants shall be fixed by the Fiscal Court not later than the first Monday in May in the year in which the officers are elected” (May 4th of 2026).
- C. It is ordered that the Coroner’s salary is increased to the sum of \$7,758.13 per month (\$93,097.58 annually), less statutory deductions. This is pursuant to KRS 64.530 (3) which requires that the monthly compensation of county officers (except the Judge Executive, the County Clerk, the Jailer, and the Sheriff as set out in KRS 64.535) elected by popular vote and including the County Attorney, the salary of the “officer and of his deputies and assistants shall be fixed by the Fiscal Court not later than the first Monday in May in the year in which the officers are elected” (May 4th of 2026).
- D. It is ordered that the salary of the County Attorney is increased to the sum of \$5,417.61 per month (\$65,011.30 annually), less statutory deductions. This is pursuant to KRS 64.530 (3) which requires that the monthly compensation of county officers (except the Judge Executive, the County Clerk, the Jailer, and the Sheriff as set out in KRS 64.535) elected by popular vote and including the County Attorney, the salary of the “officer and of his deputies and assistants shall be fixed by the Fiscal Court not later than the first Monday in May in the year in which the officers are elected” (May 4th of 2026).
- E. It is ordered that McCracken County Fiscal Court accept the KACo Anthem proposal for group health (increase of 3.41%) coverage for July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, as presented by HUB International.

- F. It is ordered that McCracken County Fiscal Court accept the One America proposal for group life (increase from \$0.160 to \$0.205 per \$1,000) coverage for July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, as presented by HUB International.
- G. It is ordered that the Judge Executive is authorized to sign the County Road Aid Cooperative Program Agreement for FY27 funds.
- H. It is ordered to pay poll workers for the 2026 Primary Election on May 19, 2026.
- I. It is ordered to pay the invoices dated March 12, 2026, to Uline for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$30,905.83. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.
- J. It is ordered to pay the invoices dated February 25, 2026, to Uline for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$414.06. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.
- K. It is ordered to pay the invoice dated April 6, 2026, to Pet Waste Eliminator for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$4,304.00. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.
- L. It is ordered to pay the invoice dated April 15, 2026, to Troutman Sign Graphics Inc for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$9,900.00. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.
- M. It is ordered that the following vehicles and equipment previously used by McCracken County are declared as surplus to be sold at a future auction.
